

# Stripy Dragon Sock Puppet

You will need:

- one stripy sock
- scraps of felt or other stiff material
- sequins
- glue
- a needle and thread
- sharp scissors



## Making the Dragon

Cut out the dragon spikes, eyes, ears and eyebrows from the scraps of felt or material. Cut out two tiny circles for nostrils.

Push your hand and arm into the stripy sock and mark where you are going to put the eyes, nostrils and ears with a felt-tip pen. Take off the sock and carefully glue into place making sure you don't stick the sock together. Add the eyebrows - adjusting the angle makes the dragon look more, or less scary. Pinch the ears together at the bottom and secure with a couple of stitches (or a staple) and sew on to the side of the dragons head. Using glue, or a needle and thread sandwich three sets of spikes together so the the middle one sticks up above the outer two. Glue or sew down the back of the sock. Add extra sequins or buttons to finish if you want.
