

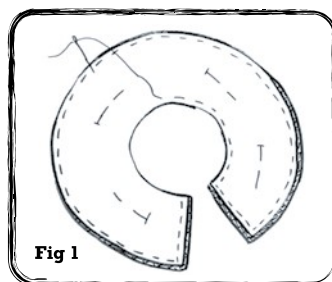
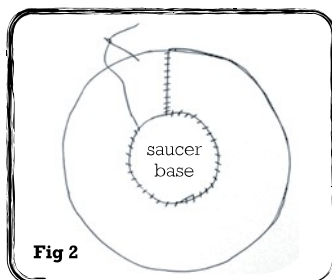
Teacups



Instructions

Saucer

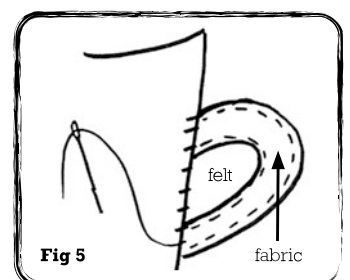
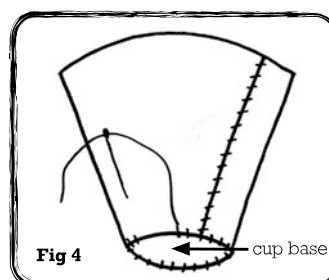
1. Cut out one piece of fabric and one piece of felt for each shape. **Fig 1.**
2. Place the fabric shape on top of the felt shape, pin and sew around with a small running stitch and sewing thread, to hold together. Repeat for both saucer pieces.



3. Overlap the edges of the main saucer piece by about 0.5 cms and sew with a little over and over stitch. **Fig 2.**
4. Place the base underneath, and sew with an over and over stitch. **Fig 2.**

Cup

1. Cut out one piece of fabric and one piece of felt for each shape.
2. Sew the fabric and felt shapes together as for the saucer. **Fig 3.**
3. Overlap the edges of the cup piece by about 0.5 cm and sew with an over and over stitch.
4. Place the base underneath and sew on with an over and over stitch. **Fig 4.**
5. Cut out a piece of felt the same shape as the whole handle, and a piece of fabric with the inside cut out so it is more handle shaped. Sew the two pieces together with a small running stitch, then attach to the side of the cup with an over and over stitch. **Fig 5.**



Patterns

Cut one piece of fabric and one piece of felt for each of the cup and saucer shapes

Sew two or three stitches on the spot to stop your thread unravelling

Don't forget to tie a small knot at the end of your thread to stop it coming through
