

bunnies

Fold felt in half and pin patterns on. Draw around paper and cut ON THE LINE you have drawn. see fig 1 Sew on eyes and whiskers to one bunny head using the lines on the paper pattern as a guide. Thread needle with embroidery thread and tie a knot. Pin the bunny shapes together with the eyes on the outside and sew around using an over and over stitch from A to B. See fig 2 Push a little stuffing through the gap and finish sewing. Make a few stitches on the spot to stop your thread unravelling.






- Din the two body pieces together and sew all the way round remembering to leave a gap for stuffing. Stuff and finish sewing. Attach the head to the body with a few stitches at the back.
- 10 Roll a little stuffing in to a ball and sew it on as a tail.
- Decorate their hutch and show your bunnies their new home.




Carrots

Cut out the carrot shapes from the orange and green felt. Roll the orange piece in to a cone around the green carrot top and sew it closed. You might find it easier to hold the carrot closed with a pin while you sew it. See fig 3
